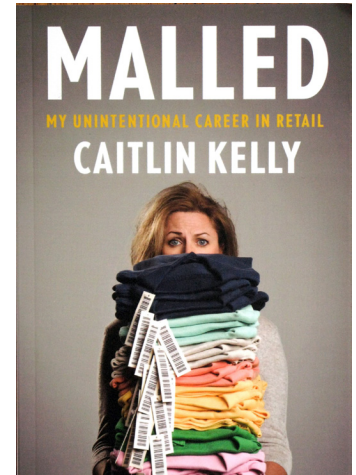


Store Clerks & Shoppers: Low Wages, No Bargain
