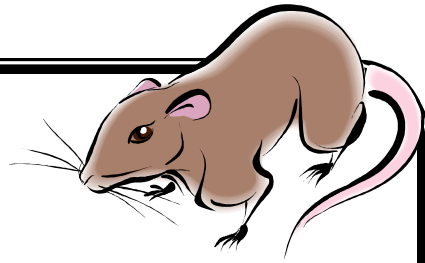

Rat Prevention training scheduled for Tuesday January 10, 2012, 1:00 pm to 4:30 pm

Course Description:

The goal of this training is to encourage best practices in preventative maintenance and to help neighborhoods experiencing high rates of infestation remediate problem conditions.

New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene has developed a program to educate the public on rodent control in their neighborhoods. This half-day training is targeted to superintendents, building staff, property managers, homeowners, interested tenants and the local business community. Attendees will learn about the steps building operators and homeowners can take to achieve a rat-free property through an Integrated Pest Management (IPM) approach. All Bronx participants who complete the training will receive a rat management certificate, and a rat-resistant trash can as well as an ability to institute a rat management plan for their property.

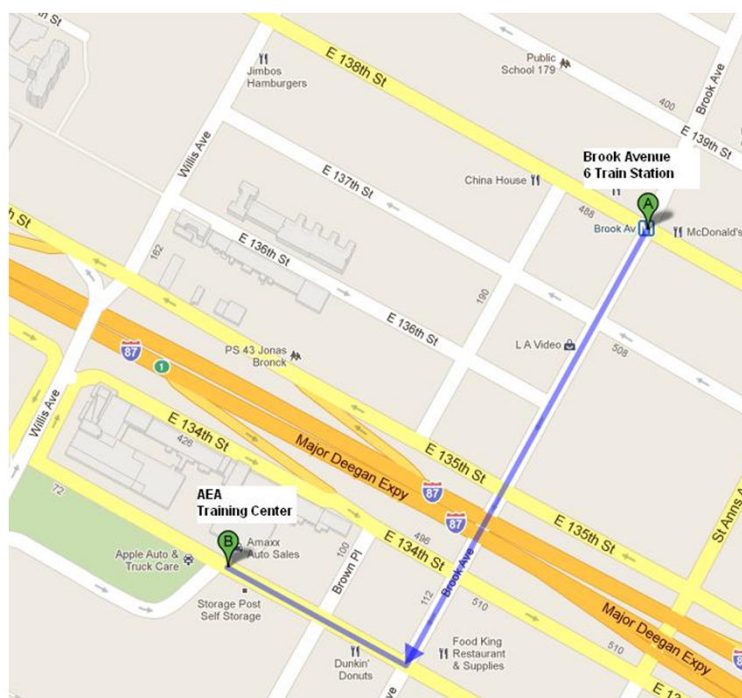
Directions:
