Warner Bros. Pictures is in production for the upcoming feature film entitled, *Extremely Loud & Incredibly Close*. The project is an adaptation of the book by Jonathan Safran Foer and will be directed by Stephen Daldry (*The Reader, The Hours, Billy Elliot*).

We are scheduled to film in your area on  
**MONDAY, JULY 11<sup>th</sup>, 2011** from approx. **7:00 AM** until **10:00 PM**

For the purposes of staging scenes and parking production vehicles, **PARKING** will be held in advance of filming on these blocks:

- **5<sup>th</sup> Avenue b/w 72<sup>nd</sup> & 73<sup>rd</sup> Streets (East Side)**
- **East 72<sup>nd</sup> Street b/w 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue & Madison Avenue [Western 1/2 of block] (North Side)**
- **Cherry Hill Circle & Central Park Entrance Roads (per Central Park Conservancy)**

**PLEASE OBSERVE POSTED 'NO PARKING' SIGNS TO AVOID ANY  
INCONVENIENCE**

In order to avoid holding parking spaces many days in advance of filming, we will use the Vehicle Tow Unit (VTU) of the NYPD to relocate any remaining cars parked in our designated parking areas prior to filming. We will post signs 48 hours in advance of relocation. There is no cost or penalty to owners of relocated vehicles. In the event that your car is relocated, contact our location department at **718.780.6466** and we will tell you where your car can be found. We urge you to pay attention to the signs to avoid any inconvenience. This is the same program that is used for parades and other public events throughout the city.

We understand that filming can be somewhat disruptive, and we appreciate your cooperation. If you have special needs such as deliveries, moving, traveling, or construction, please contact the Locations Department. As guests in your neighborhood, we will make every effort to be respectful of the daily routine of the community.
